What Can I Sell?

PLEASE NOTE: We will not be accepting toys at our February 27, 2010 Spring Sales. We will be having a Toy Tent Sale at our June 19, 2010 sale. Books, CD/DVD/VHS and puzzles/puzzle boxes will be accepted at ALL SALES. Contact us if you have a question about a specific item.

We limit sales to seasonal items; Winter/Fall items for fall sales and Spring/Summer items for Spring Sales. Fall sales are generally held between August and November and Spring sales are held between March and June.

Below is a partial list of what you can sell. If you have an item that isn't on the list, chances are you can sell it at the sale if it is in good condition and is used by babies, children, pregnant or nursing moms. Please, feel free to email us at help@thechildrensclothesline.com should you have any questions about what you can or cannot sell.

All items MUST be cleaned and checked for safety recall prior to consignment. (Check for recalls at www.cpsc.gov)

Clothing - Any clothing newborn to preteen size 16; hats, christening gowns, special occasion clothing, swim wear, etc.

Nursery Furniture - Cribs, changing tables, bassinets, cradles, gliders, rockers, ottomans, baby monitors, diaper pails, etc.

Baby Equipment - New baby bottles, boppy pillows, diaper bags, lunchboxes, new cups, new feeding accessories, humidifiers, bathtubs, potty seats, booster seats, high chairs, backpacks, snugglies, baby backpacks, exersaucers, walkers, strollers, bouncers, swings, etc.

Nursery Décor and Accessories - Bedding sets for children, pictures, lamps, desks, frames, mobiles, wall hangings, children's furniture, dressers, youth beds, toy boxes, night lights, etc.

Infant / Children's Bedding - Bedding sheets for bassinets, cradles, cribs, youth beds, twin beds, comforter sets, receiving blankets, baby blankets, changing pads, head supports, etc.

Shoes - Boots, sneakers, sandals, slippers, all must be in excellent condition!

Costumes - Halloween, dance, dress-up outfits, accessories, etc.

Outside Toys & Equipment - Big plastic toys, yard toys, slides, sandboxes, wagons, riding toys, tricycles, play yards, playground sets, etc.

Maternity - clothing (in style and in good condition), pregnancy books, parenting books, etc.

Children's/Baby Toys - Books, games (board, computer and video), puzzles, dolls, electronic toys, pull toys, trucks, action figures, blocks, etc.

Children's Music & Videos - DVDs, CDs, VHS and video games - Please no PG13, NC17, or R rated materials

Sorry, We Cannot Accept the Following Items

- Any item that has been safety recalled - (www.cpsc.gov)
- Car seats or booster seats
- Crib mattresses (it is illegal to sell these in Massachusetts)
- Baby equipment that is not clean
- Used pacifiers, bottles, cups, spoons or other feeding accessories
- Used hair ornaments (headbands, barrettes, etc.)
- Any underwear or socks that are not brand new
- Opened personal care products such as baby powder, soaps, lotions, etc.
- Any item that is stained, torn, extremely worn or out of date.
- Items with missing buttons, broken zippers or lost parts
- Perishable Items
- Pool Toys
- Stuffed Animals or Beanie babies
- Battery operated toys without batteries
- Bedding that is not for children
- Bags of loose toys unless theme oriented (i.e. bags of all army toys, all Barbie toys, etc.)
- Jewelry - due to the number of recalls, this also includes children's jewelry.
- Magazines
- Adult Clothing - misses or men's clothing
- Toys from fast food restaurants
